He is a member of the FC DELCO Hall of Fame. Cox played college soccer at the University of Richmond and trained with professional clubs in Argentina, Holland, Belgium and Germany. Coach Cox was an NCAA I Assistant Men's Coach at Drury University and Bradley University. Cox participated in the NCAA I Tournament as both a player and assistant men's coach. Cox was the Varsity Boys Soccer Head Coach at EA from 2004-2008. Additionally, he coached the FC DELCO Hammerheads to three EPYSA State Championships, three consecutive US Youth Soccer Region I Championships and three National Final Fours from 2005-2008. Coach Cox has assisted in the coaching of over five players in Major League Soccer and has helped numerous youth players receive NCAA scholarships. He holds an NSCAA Advanced National Coaching Diploma and is currently a personal soccer trainer, camp director and head coach of the elite U-12 Lower Merion SC Lightning.
