

LMSC Panthers & Philabundance 2012



In the midst of a busy season of tournaments and showcases, the LMSC Panthers made time to volunteer for two Saturdays at Philabundance. Since 1984, Philabundance's mission has been to reduce hunger and food insecurity in the Delaware Valley by providing food access to those in need in partnership with organizations and individuals. Philabundance is the region's largest hunger relief organization, and serves low income residents at risk of hunger and malnutrition, of which 23% are children and 16% are senior citizens. On Saturday, June 23rd, the LMSC Panthers helped fill two-pound bags of Great Northern Beans. Altogether, the Panthers helped to pack 2,430 pounds of beans. A week later, June 30th, the Panthers returned to help sort over two tons of meat. Without help from volunteers like the Panthers, Philabundance would be unable to distribute food to so many residents of the greater Philadelphia area.
