FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM REGISTRATION

***THIS NEWSLETTER CONTAINS
REGISTRATION INFORMATION FOR OUR
FALL INTRAMURAL SOCCER PROGRAM
AS WELL AS APPLICATIONS FOR FIELD
CREW AND INTRAMURAL REFFING.***

Our Fall Intramural Program will be open to boys and girls not playing in the Travel Team Program who were born between 1985 and 1993. Players do NOT have to live within Lower Merion Township.

The program will start on Saturday, September 12th and run through November 14th.

Like all of our programs at LMSC, the primary goal of the Fall Intramural Program is: **"To provide each and every youngster with a fun filled experience in a soccer environment."**

In previous seasons, LMSC has guaranteed acceptance in the Fall Intramural Program for all registrations received by August 10th. Due to the fact that a few divisions have had a shortage of coaches in both our Fall Intramural Program and our Spring Intramural Program, we are now only able to guarantee acceptance in the program IF WE HAVE ENOUGH COACHES. If we do not get enough coaches to volunteer in a division, then we will only take enough players to fill teams with coaches, regardless of when registrations are received.

Late registrations will be accepted ONLY if there are openings in the specified division. Additional registration forms may be picked up on our web page or at Sneaky Pete's Discount Sneakers (now at 5 West Lancaster Avenue in Ardmore) AFTER July 1st.

NEW LMSC DIRECTORS

This spring, LMSC has named several new people as Directors to the Club. The new leadership has enabled the club to give more attention to each program and make changes that will make the club even stronger.

Bruno Ceccarelli remains as President of LMSC and Biff Sturla remains as Vice President. Last season, Nancy Worby became Director of the Girls Travel Team Program while Allan Greaves took over as Director of the Boys Travel Team Program.

New in 1998 are Dan Sutton, Bryan Richardson and Marty Rubenstein. All three are actively involved in both the Travel Team Program and the Intramural Program.

Dan will be in charge of our oldest intramural divisions and will help Nancy to run the Girls Travel Team Program. Dan is also a head travel team coach.

Marty Rubenstein has taken over as the club's Legal Counsel. Marty is the head coach for our Under 11 'A' boys travel team and also coaches intramural soccer in both the boys and girls 5 year old programs.

LMSC would like to welcome our new Directors. With these additions, LMSC should have the leadership to make our 31st season the best one ever.

The Directors would also like to thank Joe Hopkins, who served as Director, Treasurer and Travel Team coach the past 10 years. Joe's work and leadership helped LMSC grow from 700 players in 1989 to the present count of 2500. With his two boys now in college, one playing at University of Pennsylvania, Joe has resigned as Director and coach in LMSC in order to pursue the ever elusive "life after soccer." All of us at LMSC thank Joe very much for his ten years of excellent leadership.

The faster turnaround is possible since on many nights, all of the LMSC Directors are on soccer fields and do not get in to return phone calls in a timely manner. Our LMSC web page also contains a lot of information for our club. We now are able to post team assignments and division schedules for our Intramural Programs as well as for Sports Rink Indoor Soccer. Registration material is also available for our Intramural Programs as are Travel Team tryout schedules, Summer Soccer Camp registrations, links to top soccer sites and photos of various international players.

For travel teams, we will be adding directions to opposing club's fields in our new "Coaches Corner" section on our web page. This will be an ongoing effort. Travel teams are asked to mail or e-mail directions to any fields that you play on this fall.

If anyone has suggestions on how we can make our web page more useful to LMSC members, please feel free to let us know. We are hoping to make our web page a valuable tool in sharing information with our players and their families.

U.S.S.F. COACHING COURSE GRADUATES

Each year we allocate a significant size of our budget to making our coaches (intramural and travel) better prepared to coach. Depending on the program, we distribute various coaching manuals and coaching videos so that our coaches will be able to accomplish more with their teams.

Each year, we pay the full cost to any LMSC coach who takes one of the six different coaching courses sponsored by the United States Soccer Federation. Many of our intramural coaches have completed the nine hour 'F' level course.

Almost all of our head coaches in the Travel Team Program have completed the 18 hour 'E' level course, many coaches in the older age groups have completed the 36 hour 'D' course.

This spring, LMSC Director Allan Greaves completed the very extensive, 60 hour National 'C' level license course. Allan is in charge of the Boys Travel Team Program. He is also the head coach for our U-10 'A' boys team, the LMSC Rovers as well as the U-13 Delco Select team.

Information about future coaching courses and clinics will be mailed out to all coaches on our mailing list. LMSC will pay the full cost of all coaching courses that are completed by coaches within our program.

FALL REFEREE AND FIELD CREW APPLICATIONS

Enclosed in this newsletter is an application form for the positions of referee and field crew for the 1998 Fall Intramural Program. We have modified the various referee positions and pay scale for the 1998 Fall season. Below is a description of each of the positions.

If you are interested in working this fall in any of the positions, please fill out and mail back the application form to our Gladwyne address. Applications should be received no later than August 10th. The intramural season will begin on Saturday, September 12th and run through November 14th. Games are played each Saturday during that time period.

Referees will NOT have to be available each Saturday. They will only be asked to work on days that their personal schedule permits them. We are especially looking for girls who play in the Travel Team Program since most of their games are on Sundays.

LEVEL 3 REFEREES - Must be at least 17 years of age OR be at least 15 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 3 Referees will be used for games in our 9-13 year old divisions. These games pay \$14 a game.

LEVEL 2 REFEREES - Must be at least 15 years of age OR be at least 13 years of age with at least two years of referee experience. Level 2 Referees will be used for games in our 7-10 year old divisions. These games pay \$12 a game.

Games for level 3 and level 2 referees last one hour. Games are played on Saturdays at many different sites.

LEVEL 1 REFEREES - Must be at least 13 years of age OR be at least 11 years of age with a minimum of two years of Travel Team playing experience. No prior referee experience is necessary.

Level 1 Referees will be used for games in our 5-6 year old divisions. These games pay \$10.00 per session (each session is approximately 75 minutes long). These referees will also be expected to help the coaches teach the basic skills and tactics of the game to the players as well as help with the skills clinic held at the start of each session.

ALL Referees will be expected to dress in soccer attire and must provide their own whistle. The referee assignor will call all referees each Thursday to find out which referees are available for that weekend.

The referee assignor this fall will again be Suzie Grech. Rules and regulations will be forwarded to the referees.

FIELD CREW - Field crew members must be at least 13 years of age. Starting August 1st, workers will be paid \$12 an hour to set up nets, line fields, remove trash and

take down nets. Each week, they will need to have nets set up on Friday night or Saturday morning by 9:00 AM.

We will have a Head Field Crew person at each of our fields. The Field Crew head call people on the field crew list to help complete their work. If you are interested in any of these positions, please return the enclosed application form no later than August 10th.

STATE CUP RESULTS

Each year our travel teams Under 11 and up are eligible to compete in both the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups.

This winter, our Under 14 girls, the LMSC Dynamite made it to the semifinals of the Indoor State Cups. The Dynamite won four straight games to reach the semis. Scoring came from Lydia Williams, Brianne Redelheim, Martha Kelley, Morgan McCann, Liz Donahue and Bridget Campbell. Goaltender Helen Eisner starred in goal, supported by strong defensive play of Kirsten Lawson, Emily Clark, Margaux Viola, Nicole Bolognone, Dorie Prince and Kristen Maze. The Dynamite is coached by Chris Campbell. In the Dynamite's two other indoor tournaments this winter, they came in first place and second place.

In 1990, the U-13 Gorillas won the Indoor and Outdoor State Cups in the same season. They are one of only nine teams in the state to ever accomplish that feat.

HELP WANTED, HELP WANTED

LMSC will be looking to hire one or more adults starting in August for part time administrative work. This is necessitated by the huge growth in our program. We will be looking for responsible people age 16 or older who have been with the program before in some capacity (coach, parent, player, etc.) to do the following jobs.

These are all paid positions:

Fall Registration Assistant - This position requires a person to regularly handle the inflow of mail (including about 1600 Fall Intramural Registrations) and process the mail in a proper and timely manner. A PC and computer skills are required for this position.

Hotline Assistant - This position requires a person to regularly retrieve messages from our LMSC Hotline and return calls in a timely manner. During the two weeks leading up to the start of the fall season, we receive an average of over 50 calls a day.

Paperwork Assistant - This position requires a person to photocopy and distribute the necessary coaches forms, manuals, game and field schedules as well the letters, rosters and schedules that go to the 1600 intramural players at the beginning of the season.

These are all paid positions. Much of the work can be done from home. The positions require people to be in town between August 1st and September 10th. If you are interested in any of these positions, please send a letter with your name, soccer background and prior work or administrative experience to our Gladwyne address.

PERSONAL SOCCER TRAINING

Many players, both travel and intramural have been signing up for personal soccer training. LMSC endorses two different programs in the area. While these two programs are NOT affiliated with LMSC, we do feel that they are run by highly qualified soccer people.

Allan Greaves offers personal, one-on-one training as well as small group training to young soccer players. Allan has been an active soccer player for over 24 years. In 1997, Allan was a member of the Philadelphia Freedom Professional team. He is an assistant coach with the Radnor High School boys varsity, head coach for the Under 13 Delco League Select Team and head coach for our U-10 'A' boys Rovers team. Danielle Fagan, our U-12 'A' Girls Travel Team Head Coach and Rose Miller, our U-13 'A' Girls Travel Team Head Coach offer fun individual skills training to female players. Both Danielle and Rose are former players on the Villanova University Women's soccer team and other select teams. Both have a lot of experience in the

competitive soccer arena and know what it takes to be the best while enjoying the game and all it has to offer.

Danielle is a former Assistant Coach for the Villanova Women's Team. Both Danielle and Rose are former players and team captains at Villanova. While the LMSC Directors fully endorse both of these programs and the coaches that run them, it must be noted that both programs are independent of LMSC.

ADULT WOMEN'S SOCCER

Now in it's fourth season, the LMSC Adult Women's Program continues to expand. The program offers both competitive soccer and instructional soccer to adult women, regardless of previous soccer experience.

This winter, the Moonlight Ladies entered two teams in the six team Women's Indoor League at Rockets Sports in Wayne. At the conclusion of the end of season playoffs, the Moonlight Ladies Red team were crowned champions when they defeated Swarthmore. Goalie Angel DiPilla earned a shutout in the game while Nancy McKenna led the offensive charge. Robin Abi-Khattar and Margot Guiliano led a very determine defense.

This spring, the team entered the brand new Tri-County Women's League which consists of six teams. The league was founded by Karin Sturla who also started the LMSC Adult Women's Program. Sturla was elected by the Tri-County League to serve as their first President.

The league will offer soccer to adult women in the spring, winter and fall season. Their long term goal is to have an Open Division for experienced players and a Novice Division for less experienced players.

The primary focus of their program is to offer adult women a chance to play soccer, regardless of whether they have any prior experience. The team works on fundamental skills and tactics each week, as well as play in small sided games at practice. The LMSC teams are coached by Tom Starke, Traci Brody and Michael Mark, all of whom have a very extensive soccer background.

Many of the players have little or no prior playing experience. Many players are mothers of LMSC Travel Team Players or Intramural Players. The team warmly welcomes new players, regardless of their soccer background. If you would like to join, please call our LMSC Hotline or send an e-mail.
